#### Dear Virtual Pose® Artist,

It's been a while since my last update, and I'm happy to share some good news for those of you who'd like to practice using our complimentary Virtual Pose® Sessions™ sample, available here:

https://www.virtualpose.net/greenstore2020/sessions.html

There is now a safe and reliable FLASH emulator called **RUFFLE** that allows Flash® content to run again in modern browsers such as Chrome and Firefox.

We've tested it ourselves and can confirm it works well with the Virtual Pose Sessions.

Tou can download the RUFFLE emulator here:

Once installed as a browser extension, you should be able to open and interact with the free Session sample on the page above.

## Nhat Virtual Pose® Sessions™ Is (and Isn't)

Virtual Pose® (VP) Session™ is **not** a rotation or animation of a single pose. Instead, it's a **slideshow** of different poses — all featuring the same model, photographed from a consistent viewpoint.

Each image shows the model in a different position, designed to help artists build confidence and speed through **gesture drawing exercises**.

## ✓ How to Use a Session

When a VP Session first launches, it will briefly play quickly — that's normal.

You'll then see a prompt on screen:

"ENTER a VALUE for SECONDS (1-99)"

Type a number between 1 and 99 - this will set how long each pose appears on screen.

# For example:

Enter 10 → each pose shows for 10 seconds

Enter 1 or 2 → rapid gesture sketching

Click " ${\sf PLAY}$ " — and the slideshow will begin, advancing automatically.

## Randomized Image Order

Each time you click "PLAY," the order of the images is shuffled.

This is **intentional** — it prevents memorization and helps simulate the spontaneity of a live model session, which is ideal for gesture drawing drills.

## Already Purchased a Session? Read On (for Mac and PC Users)

If you previously purchased any of our à la carte Sessions $^{\text{TM}}$  — only to find yourself locked out when Adobe phased out Flash — and you're a **Mac or PC user**, here's how to run them again locally.

How to Operate VP Sessions™ Directly on Your Mac or PC

#### Step-by-Step

First, download the Ruffle Desktop App for Mac or Windows (among others!)

https://ruffle.rs/downloads

To do that...

Scroll to the "Desktop" section and choose:

- Mac Application (.dmg)
- Windows Installer (.exe)

Then...

#### 1. Install the App

- Mac: Open the downloaded .dmg file and drag the Ruffle icon into your Applications folder.
- PC: Run the .exe file and follow the setup instructions.

#### 2. Launch Ruffle

- Mac: Open Ruffle from your Applications folder.
- PC: Launch Ruffle from your Start Menu or Desktop.

### **Open Your Session File**

In the app, go to:

File → Open...

Select the file, for example:

Session008.swf



The session will begin playing instantly.



#### A Note About macOS Security

Because Ruffle is open-source software and not (yet) registered with Apple's developer system, your Mac may display the following message:

"Apple could not verify 'libopenh264-2.4.1-mac-arm64.dylib' is free of malware that may harm your Mac or compromise your privacy."

This is expected and does not indicate that anything is wrong. You may see this message twice — once when you first launch the app, and again when the library is accessed during playback.

We've tested Ruffle extensively and can confirm that this alert is purely a standard macOS safeguard. The file is safe, and once approved, it won't prompt you again.

# **V** To Continue:

- 1. Click "Done"
- 2. Go to System Preferences → Security & Privacy
- 3. Under the General tab, click "Allow Anyway"
- 4. Reopen Ruffle and approve once more when prompted

After that, Ruffle will run normally.
